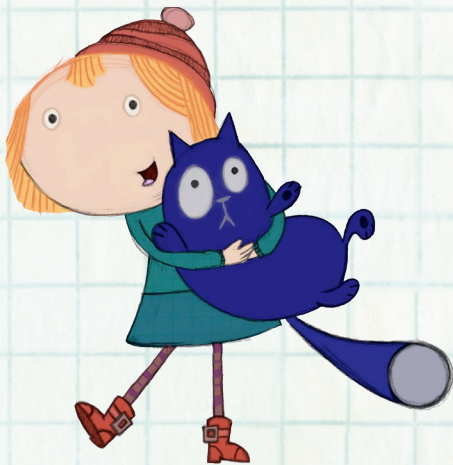


About the Creators

Jennifer Oxley, Co-Creator, *Peg + Cat*

Jennifer Oxley was born in Hollywood, California, and caught the filmmaking bug early—she made her first film at the age of seven. Since then she has directed fifteen short films for *Sesame Street*, as well as the award-winning adaptation of Spike Lee and Tonya Lewis Lee's children's book *Please, Baby, Please*. Her short film *The Music Box* was acquired by the Museum of Modern Art for its permanent children's film collection. Her work in children's television includes directing and artistic credits. She is the recipient of an Emmy Award for her role as director on *Little Bill*, and she created the look and animation style of *Wonder Pets!*, which won an Environmental Media Award and the prestigious Japan Prize. Most recently Jennifer Oxley teamed up with Billy Aronson to create the hit PBS KIDS animated series *Peg + Cat*.



Peg + Cat is the Emmy Award-winning animated TV series created by Jennifer Oxley and Billy Aronson and produced by The Fred Rogers Company. It was named Best New Series at the 2015 Kidscreen Awards.

Billy Aronson's one-act plays have been produced in eight Ensemble Studio Theatre Marathons and published in six volumes of *The Best American Short Plays* as well as in Broadway Play Publishing's *Funny Shorts*. His full-length plays have premiered at Playwrights Horizons, the Woolly Mammoth Theatre, the San Francisco Playhouse, and 1&12 Productions. His writing for the musical theater includes the original concept and additional lyrics for the Broadway musical *Rent* and the book for the Theatreworks USA musical *Click, Clack, Moo*. With artist Jennifer Oxley he created *Peg + Cat*, an animated PBS KIDS series that won three Emmy Awards in its first season. With his wife, Lisa Vogel, he created Jake and Anna, their animated offspring.
