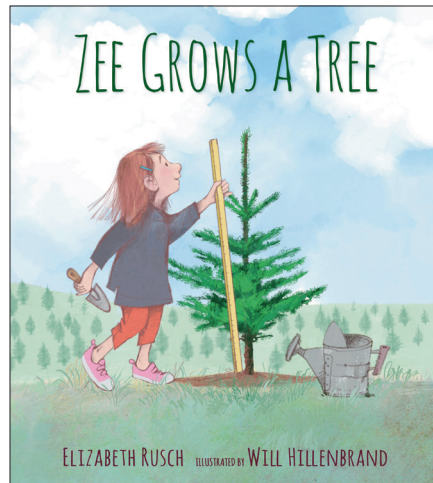


ZEE GROWS A TREE

ZEE GROWS A TREE

- ▲ The author uses both narrative and nonfiction text to tell Zee's story. Ask students to describe the difference between these two text types.
- ▲ Discuss the similarities and differences between Zee and her tree.
- ▲ Have students plant seeds, care for them, and mark their growth the way Zee does with her tree.
- ▲ Use the simple index at the back of the book to introduce young readers to the concept of using an index.
