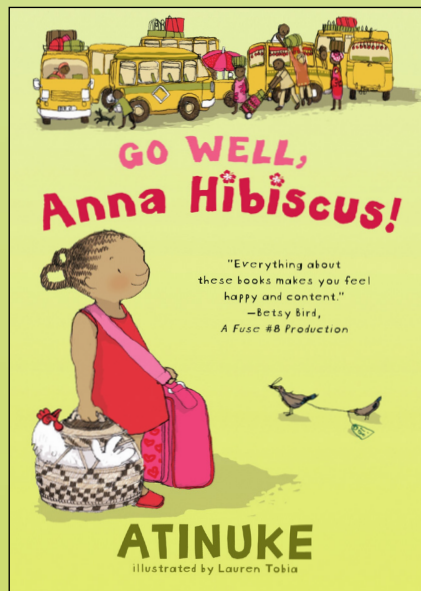


The spirited Anna Hibiscus leaves the city of Lagos to visit her grandparents' remote village in the bush.
